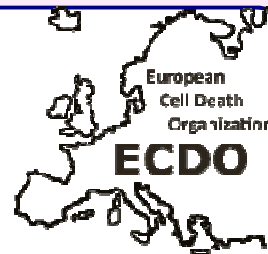


# ECDO NEWSLETTER 2019/1

The 26<sup>th</sup> Conference of the European Cell Death Organization, entitled "Cell death in disease: from small molecules to translational medicine", was held in Saint Petersburg, Russia on October 10-12, 2018.



The meeting had a fabulous scientific programme featuring top speakers from Europe, Japan, Australia, USA and Canada. Special highlights were the CDD Jürg Tschopp Prize Lecture delivered by Prof. Vishva Dixit from Genentech and the ECDO Honorary Lecture given by Anthony Letai from the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute of Harvard Medical School. There were ample possibilities for networking for early career researchers.
